

Subject Line: Invitation to Participate in Research

Hello,

You are being invited to participate in a study that I am conducting in Ontario as part of a transnational project. Briefly, the study explores how colonially entrenched racial inequities play out in the work of Black (of African descent) school leaders (principals and vice-principals) in Ontario. If you choose to participate, you will be asked to engage in a 1-hour interview with an interviewer of your choice: Dr. Katina Pollock (White), Dr. Annette Walker (Black) or Ms. Omotoyosi Ogunbanwo (Black) and potentially be invited to participate in a 2-hour follow-up focus group. If invited to the follow-up focus group session, you will be encouraged to work alongside the research team to help co-construct or reframe understandings of racial inequity to disrupt colonially entrenched disparities in your work.
